

ELEMENT TITLE:

Section Number

DEFINITION: The code used by the institution to differentiate among multiple sections of a specific course.

FORMAT: alphanumeric - 6 characters

CODES: Institution's preferred code
Blank not valid
Same codes must be used in CIS and SRS

Example: Computer Science/Information Technology 210 section 03,
Designated CSIT 210 03
03 is the section number

COMMENTS: Cannot be Blank. Section Number must match in Course Information System (CIS) and Student Registration System (SRS).

RELATED TO: Course Subject, Course Number, Course Credit Value
