**Course Session**

DEFINITION: A code used by the institution to differentiate the same course offered more than once during the same reporting term.

FORMAT: alphanumeric - 3 characters

CODES: Institution's preferred code  
Blank not valid  
Same codes must be used in both CIS and SRS

Ex: Computer Science/Information Technology 210 Section 03, Session A

Designated as CSIT 210 03 A

A is the course session

COMMENTS: Cannot be Blank. Course Session must match in Course Information System (CIS) and Student Registration System (SRS).

RELATED TO: Course Subject, Course Number, Section Number, Credit Value
