## FAIS Summary of Changes for 2020-21 Submission

- 1. The most significant change/clarification for FAIS 2020-21 is data element <u>DD85</u> has been renamed from Aid Category Award Amount to Financial Aid Disbursement Amount. The FAIS layout and header record reflects this name change. The definition in the Data Dictionary has been modified to reflect MHEC's expectation that institutions report aid disbursed. Institutions that will have difficulty adhering to this definition should contact Barbara Schmertz at <u>barbara.schmertz@maryland.gov</u>, with concerns or questions.
- 2. New data element edit checks added for FATAL errors:

When DD77 – Financial Aid Application Status is equal to zero (0), meaning there is no FAFSA, the following seven fields require the specific values shown below:

- DD142 Parent 1 Highest Grade Level must be blank
- DD143 Parent 2 Highest Grade Level must be blank
- DD78 Family Size must be blank
- DD79 Dependency Status must equal zero (0)
- DD80 Commuter Status must equal zero (0)
- DD81 Expected Family Contribution must equal 99999999 (unknown)
- DD83 Adjusted Gross Income must equal 99999999 (unknown)

When there is no FAFSA (=0) and these fields do not contain the proper values, fatal errors will display on the edit report.

- 3. New data element edit checks added for WARNINGS:
  - DD81 When Expected Family Contribution > 9999999 or equal to 9999999, 999999, 9999, 999, 99, or 9

  - DD84 Amount of Award is equal to DD85 Aid Category Code

A new warning will display if one of first two statements are true. The goal is to notify user to review the populated field to confirm the entry making sure it should not be unknown.

For the third statement, a warning will display if the amount equals the aid category code.

4. The records in the FAIS file must be submitted as a comma separated formatted file with a .csv extension. <u>PLEASE DO NOT</u> include spaces between commas in the .csv file. The <u>FAIS header</u> must be downloaded and submitted with the file.
